

The meeting began at 3:00 p.m. Attending were Sally Wennes, Jill Heninger, Alice Cole, Linda McAfee, Kathie Lester, Christi Htway, Linda Legman, Mary Opdahl, Sandy Chagi, Sandy Thomas, Sylvia McKnight, and Don Venardos. The January minutes were reviewed. Don motioned approval, Sandy seconded, all approved.

Public Comment – Linda Legman asked what can be done to make positive comments about Glenwood in the community. She shared UACT will be sponsoring a blood drive on “pink day” March 13th to promote a positive message to the community. Glenwood will be celebrating a 45th anniversary, funded by the PTA. There will be two magician shows one during the day for all students and another in the evening for families.

DAC – The Bylaws have changed. The “Marketing for Schools” is being promoted to bring students back to the district. The district plans to place the new charter school, MATES, on the Glenwood campus. Campus changes at Glenwood will not begin until it is definite MATES will be coming here. The PTA chose: principal, Office Manager, Office Clerk, Site Tech, IMT, Cluster Counselor and discretionary allocation as high priorities for the budget survey. Top low priorities chosen were: CSR for K-2 and 4-5, reduce Custodians to 1 ½, Health Clerk, Team Leaders, and Student Council Advisor. An alternate DAC rep search will be conducted.

PTA – Christi said upcoming events are a Magician assembly and the Jog-a-Thon

STAFF – UACT report by Linda Legman: the district will likely be losing temporary, new, and some tenured teachers. All teachers need to be CLAD certified by 2010. Federal funds will be increased for Special Ed and Title I by 40%. Dr. Seuss day will be celebrated on March 2 from 4 to 8 p.m. at the Thousand Oaks Library. Microsoft Money – 12 computers, some software and printers have been ordered with this fund.

New Business

PI – Our focus is on students and learning English Language Arts. Staff development workshops will be conducted along with Conejo Elementary this year and next. In March a tour will be conducted at Peach Hill in Moorpark. Their student scores have increased over 200 points over 8 years. Brekke School in Oxnard will also be visited, however, that school has a year round schedule. Muriel Miller, Denise Brown, and Sherry Luedke will be on the PI communication team for Glenwood. Linda McAfee suggested increased parent involvement would help improve student scores.

Time change of meeting – discussion was held regarding an earlier start time for the SSC meetings. It was agreed to keep the start time at 3:00.

Parent Survey – The last parent survey was conducted two years ago. A survey will be conducted in May this year. It will cover the various programs and services offered at Glenwood. Don, Kathie, Christi and Alice offered to review the survey questions. It is an on-line survey, offered in English and Spanish, and hard copies will be available if requested. Parents will also be given the opportunity to complete the survey on-line at the school lab.
